Dear Mr. Spear:

As Team Leader of the Sonoran Pronghorn Antelope Recovery Team I would like to propose a team meeting for July 31, 1987. The meeting would be held at the Luke Air Force Base @ 10:00 A.M.

I have three items for discussion including a request to you for additional team membership. The proposed agenda items are as follows:

1. Update team members on the Buenos Aires National Wildlife Refuge, Pronghorn Study Team report and my participation on the study team.
 2. Proposal for continuation, in part of the study, of Sonoran pronghorn status in Arizona.

Funding has become available from "The One-Shot Antelope Hunt Foundation" for recapturing and radio collaring of Sonoran pronghorn antelope collared during the above study and to monitor antelope movements (see attachments). Mr. Jim DeVos of the Arizona Game and Fish Department would be requested to update the team members on this proposal. Steps for obtaining special use permits etc. necessary to begin the study needs to be outlined in order for a smooth initiation of this project.

3. Proposal for additional team members to the Sonoran Pronghorn Antelope Recovery Team.

Subject to the recent resignation of Linda Hagen USFWS Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge, the team will request the Regional Director to ensure participation of the Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge with the team and to

Additionally with passage of public law 99-606 the Bureau of Land Management will assume an active role in resource management of the now named Barry M. Goldwater Range. Subsequent to the now active role that the BLM will play in land management planning and resource management the team will request the Regional Director to explore the necessity of requesting team membership from the Bureau of Land Management and if appropriate, request such membership from the Bureau of Land Management.
